## **Committee view**

1.2 The committee thanks the Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry for providing further information regarding the relevant policies and legal requirements for the storage, handling and disposal of E-monitoring data. Having considered this further information in conjunction with the statement of compatibility, the committee is satisfied that this bill does not appear to raise any human rights concerns.

## Purpose of the bill

- 1.3 This bill amends the *Fisheries Management Act 1991* and the *Fisheries Administration Act 1991* to:
  - introduce electronic monitoring (e-monitoring) to Australian boats that are authorised to fish under concessions and scientific permits granted by the Commonwealth; and
  - make several minor amendments to the FM Act to clarify and make provisions consistent.
