REPORT NO. 5 OF 2009

- 1. The committee met in private session on Thursday, 14 May 2009 at 11.34 am.
- 2. The committee resolved to recommend—That—
 - (a) the order of the Senate of 18 March 2009 adopting the committee's 3rd report of 2009 be varied to provide that the AusCheck Amendment Bill 2009 be *referred immediately* to the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 16 June 2009 (see appendix 1 for a statement of reasons for referral);
 - (b) the *provisions* of the Health Workforce Australia Bill 2009 be *referred immediately* to the Community Affairs Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 15 June 2009 (see appendix 2 for a statement of reasons for referral); and
 - (c) the *provisions* of the Nation Building Program (National Land Transport) Amendment Bill 2009 be *referred immediately* to the Rural and Regional Affairs and Transport Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 15 June 2009 (see appendix 3 for a statement of reasons for referral).
