## Senator Bushby asked:

1. For departments/agencies that provide mobile phones to Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices, what type of mobile phone is provided and the costs.
2. For departments/agencies that provide electronic equipment to Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices, what are the ongoing costs for this financial year to date? What were the running costs for 2009-10 and 2010-11?
3. Is electronic equipment (such as ipad, laptop, wireless card, vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive (not an inclusive list)) provided to department/agency staff? If yes provide details of what is provided, the purchase cost, the ongoing cost and a breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives it.
4. Please update if there have been any changes since Additional Estimates 2011-12 (Feb 2012): Does the department/agency provide their Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices with any electronic equipment? If yes, provide details of what is provided, the cost and to who it is provided.

## Answer:

1. The Department provides Blackberry and Mobile handsets to the Minister and his staff. These items have been sourced from the Telecommunications Commodities, Carriage and Associated Services Panel.

The selected standard models and costs for the Department are listed below:

## 3. Department

Electronic equipment that is considered outside a standard workstation setup (Desktop PC, Phone, Monitor and Peripherals) is provided on a requirement basis to Departmental staff. The Department has a one machine per person policy for all staff (except senior executive staff).
