  - e) Provide an update of moving recruitment advertising online. Is any recruitment still in printed materials, and if yes, why? What are the estimated savings for each year over the forward estimates?
  - f) Has the department/agency reduced its printing costs? If not, why not? Have printing costs increased, and if yes, why and by how much? Has the five per cent savings target been achieved if yes, how, or if it will not be achieved, why not? What are the estimated savings for each year over the forward estimates?

#### **CLEAN ENERGY REGULATOR**

- 1. CER will manage its budget and make resource allocation decisions in accordance with its available funding. CER continually looks for opportunities to reduce operating costs and will investigate those categories identified by the Department of Finance and Deregulation, along with others, as possible savings opportunities.

- b) CER has a current lease arrangement that expires in May 2017. Given the variables that could occur in that time it is not possible to estimate probable savings.
- c) Business Class is reserved for Senior Executive Service staff for domestic airfares and applies to all staff when travelling internationally. CER Policy states that travel should only be undertaken when it is the most effective way to achieve the Regulator's business.
- d) CER will employ external consultants and contractors when needed to meet business requirements. The need for these services will fluctuate from year to year and it is not possible to estimate savings across the forward estimates. The Clean Energy Regulator will manage its budget and make resource allocation decisions in accordance with its available funding.
- e) CER undertakes recruitment advertising in line with the Non-Campaign Recruitment Advertising Policy issued by the Department of Finance and Deregulation. The Clean Energy Regulator has ceased all recruitment advertising in print media, except for specific Senior Executive Service Positions where print media was considered a cost effective option to attract suitable applicants (section 5.3 of the Non-Campaign Recruitment Advertising Policy). The need for recruitment advertising will fluctuate from year to year and it is not possible to estimate savings across the forward estimates.
- f) CER does not anticipate a reduction in printing costs. CER will only print hard copies of a small number of essential publications. Prior to a print run being agreed, a reasonable case arguing for a print run is required. All other publications are available on the CER's Regulator's website. CER will manage its budget and make resource allocation decisions in accordance with its available funding.
