- 1– Have you had any feedback on the ‘Interim DVO information sharing system’ since its introduction in November 2016?

**Answer:**

The Office for Women has not received feedback on the Interim DVO information sharing system.

The Interim System, known formally as the Interim Order Reference Solution, will be in place until the National Order Reference System (NORS) is operational. NORS is currently being developed by the Australian Crime Intelligence Commission, and is scheduled to be delivered at the end of 2019.
