Senator McALLISTER: Do you have an organisation chart for the DTA?

Mr Slater: Yes, we do.

Ms O'Loughlin: Yes.

Senator McALLISTER: Could you table that here?

Mr Slater: I do not have it with me, but—

Ms O'Loughlin: We can arrange that for you. It is obviously on our website, but we can get a copy for you.

Senator McALLISTER: So the organisation chart that is on the website reflects the current arrangements after the MOG?

Ms O'Loughlin: I believe that is correct. I would need to double check. As Radi said, we are at a point at the moment of accommodating in the organisation some of the new responsibilities coming out of the budget as well, but we will make sure that you get the most up-to-date version.

Senator McALLISTER: Nonetheless, it would be good to get a status update about how people are presently organised. Would it be possible to get a personnel breakdown of the personnel involved in each of those branches and a description of the function of each of those branches within the structure, on notice?

Mr Slater: It can be provided.

Answer:

The organisational chart on the DTA website reflects the structure of the DTA as at 1 July 2017, post the finalisation of the machinery of government changes and recent restructure.
