**Senator Susan McDonald asked:**

Senator McDONALD: Have you received complaints about delays in responding to FOI requests?

Ms Spence: I think we have received complaints. It's not a regular issue that's raised with us. We've monitored how we're tracking against those requirements, and I think, with some minor areas where we've been one or two days late, we generally do operate within those FOI requirements.

Senator McDONALD: Are any of those about reallocations between staff members based on workloads? Ms Spence: Not that I've got in front of me. I genuinely don't know, but I'm happy to take it on notice.

**Answer:**

For requests in the period 1 October 2024 to 15 October 2025, the Civil Aviation Safety Authority has received 1 complaint about delays in processing Freedom of Information requests, however, we have no records of formal complaints regarding delays in responding to Freedom of Information requests that relate to reallocation between staff members based on workloads.
