**AE21-363 - Recent transfers to Australia of detainees from offshore IDCs - update  
to previous QoN**

Senator Nick McKim asked:

Please provide updates on the following tables provided in response to earlier questions:

a. BE20-329 – How many refugees and people who sought asylum in Australia have been transferred from Nauru or Papua New Guinea to Australia this financial year?

Please provide a breakdown of:

- i. when;
- ii. from where;
- iii. to where; and
- iv. why?

*Answer:*

Between 1 July 2020 and 31 January 2021, 45 transitory persons were temporarily transferred from a regional processing country to Australia under section 198B of the Migration Act 1958.

- i. Transfers occurred in July 2020, September 2020, December 2020 and January 2021.
- ii. All transfers were from Nauru to Australia.
- iii. More than 30 transitory persons were transferred to the Villawood Immigration Detention Centre, less than five transferred to the Brisbane Immigration Transit Accommodation and less than 15 transferred to the Northern Territory Alternative Place of Detention.
- iv. All transfers were for medical treatment not available in Nauru.
