Senator Nick McKim asked:

What is the current number of people being detained by the Australian Government in Papua New Guinea, and what cities/towns in Papua New Guinea are they located in? a. Please breakdown by refugees and asylum seekers without refugee status.

Answer:

No person under regional processing arrangements in Papua New Guinea (PNG) is detained. The majority of transferees reside in Port Moresby, with a small number living in Goroka.

As at 31 January 2021, 137 individuals were residing in PNG under regional processing arrangements, comprising 95 refugees and 42 failed asylum seekers.
