Senator Nick McKim asked:

*Answer:*

At 31 January 2021, there were 694 people in held immigration detention facilities who have previously sought asylum in Australia or held a refugee or humanitarian visa.

- a. At 31 January 2021, there were 51 people in the community under a residence determination who have previously sought asylum in Australia or held a refugee or humanitarian visa.
