In the last five financial years there have been **6920** fast track applicants that have sought judicial review of their negative Immigration Assessment Authority (IAA) decision.

Of the **6920** applications for judicial review of the IAA's decision, a total of **820** applications resulted in an outcome in favour of the applicant and **3436** matters remain as active undecided proceedings before the courts.
