# **BE21-426 - Assisted Voluntary Returns**

### Senator Nick McKim asked:

How many assisted voluntary returns have taken place to countries of origin from PNG and Nauru?

- a. How many of those men were found to be refugees by either local or Australian immigration agencies?
- b. Please provide a breakdown by country (PNG or Nauru), by sex, and by age of majority (adult or minor).

### Answer:

Between 19 July 2013 and 30 April 2021, there were 728 assisted voluntary returns to a country of origin direct from PNG and Nauru.

- a. 626 transitory persons returned from PNG:
  - 39 refugees
  - 493 asylum seekers
  - 94 failed asylum seekers
  - all returnees were adult males.
- b. 102 transitory persons returned from Nauru:
  - 13 refugees
  - 84 asylum seekers
  - five failed asylum seekers
  - 77 males and 25 females
  - 90 were adults at the time of return, and 12 were minors at time of return.
