As at 31 March 2021:

- a. there were 1,219 transitory persons in Australia
- b. 267 were under the age of 18
- c. 143 were in held detention
- d. 514 were in the community under residence determination
- e. 541 were holding a BVE
- f. 678 were unlawful non citizens
- g. 107 were born in Australia
- h. 39 were born in a regional processing country
