Senator Nick McKim asked:

Answer:

Between 1 July 2020 and 30 April 2021, 58 transitory persons transferred from a regional processing country to Australia for a temporary purpose under section 198B of the *Migration Act 1958*.

- i. July 2020 (<five), September 2020 (25), December 2020 (<five), January 2021 (18) and February 2021(13).
- ii. Nauru.
- iii. Less than five transferred to the Brisbane Immigration Transit Accommodation, less than 15 transferred to the Northern Alternative Place of Detention and 46 transferred to the Villawood Immigration Detention Centre.
- iv. Less than 60 transferred for medical purposes and less than five transferred as accompanying family.
