Answer:

Support provided under the Status Resolution Support Services (SRSS) program is dependent on a range of factors including immigration status, needs and vulnerabilities. Not all recipients are eligible to receive all available services.

<b>Band</b>	<b>Cohort</b>	<b>Support Services</b>
Band 1	Unaccompanied Minors (UAMs) in an Alternative Place of Detention (limited services)	Care and welfare, including facilitating programs and activities
Band 2	UAMs living under a Residence Determination (community detention) in the Australian community	Accommodation, carer support, case management / case worker, financial assistance, schooling package, additional health services
Band 3	Families and adults living under a Residence Determination in the Australian community	Accommodation, case management / case worker, financial assistance, additional health services.
Band 4	Short-term/transitional support for clients exiting immigration detention	Transitional accommodation, case management / case worker, financial assistance
Band 5	Asylum seekers (generally on a Bridging visa (BV) associated with a valid protection visa application or at merits review) with a higher level of needs and more complex barriers to status resolution	Case management / case worker, financial assistance, health services
Band 6	Asylum seekers (generally on BVs associated with a valid protection visa application or at merits review) with limited needs and short-term barriers to status resolution	Case management / case worker, financial assistance, health services
