Senator Stirling Griff asked:

How many children have been born to individuals transferred to a regional processing country on or after 19 July 2013, broken down by country of birth? Of these, how many are currently in Australia?

Answer:

As at 31 August 2021, 211 were born to persons transferred to a regional processing country on or after 19 July 2013:

- four in Papua New Guinea
- 46 in Nauru
- 161 in Australia

As at 31 August 2021, 185 were in Australia.
