Please provide the number of transitory persons who since 1 August 2020 have been granted a Bridging Visa E for the first time after being subject to a residence determination. Of this number, please provide:

- a. Breakdown by gender, and the number of children (under 18);
- b. Breakdown by state and territory relevant to the previous residence determination; and
- c. Breakdown by refugee status (as recognised by PNG or Nauru).

*Answer:*

Between 1 August 2020 and 31 January 2022, 274 transitory persons in Australia have been granted a Bridging E Visa for the first time after being subject to a residence determination.
