### 2019-20 Budget estimates

Please provide:

- the number of protection visa applications still awaiting decision, broken down by nationality of the applicant, for 2017-18 and the financial year to date
- the numbers of protection visa applications made in the past three financial years and year to date, broken down by the substantive visa class previously held by the person applying
- the average time taken for a decision on a protection visa
