**Answer:**

The Bureau of Infrastructure, Transport and Regional Economics (BITRE), within the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts, publishes monthly statistics on the punctuality and reliability of major domestic airlines on the BITRE website.

Consistent with the Minister's *Statement of Expectations for Airservices Australia from 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2025*, Airservices Australia is implementing strategies to maintain the continuity of air traffic control services and is keeping the department informed of actions taken to address service disruptions.
