- 1. The House met, at half-past ten o'clock a.m., pursuant to adjournment .- Mr. Speaker (the Honorabie G. J. Bell) took the Chair, and read Prayers.
- 2. PAPER .-- The following Paper was presented, by command of His Excellency the Administrator-Tariff Board-Report and Recommendations--Newsprinting Paper. Ordered to lie on the Table, and to be printed.
- 3. NEWSPRINT INDUSTRY-MINISTERIAL STATEMENT.---Mr. White (Minister for Trade and Customs), by leave, made a Ministerial Statement informing the House of the plans of the Government for assisting the manufacture in Australia of Newsprinting Paper.
- 4. SUPPLY BILL (No. 2) 1938-39.--The Order of the Day having been read for the resumption of the debate on the question, That the Bill be now read a second time-Debate resumed. Question-put and passed.-Bill read a second time.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair, and the House resolved itself into a Committee of the Whole.

(In the Committee.)

Clauses 1 to 5 agreed to. Schedule-

"The Parliament, £19,610 "-debated and agreed to. "The Prime Minister's Department, £94,010 "-debated and agreed to.

"The Department of External Affairs, £2,680 "-agreed to.

Remainder of Schedule agreed to.

Preamble agreed to.

Title agreed to.

Bill to be reported without amendment.

The House resumed; Mr. Prowse reported accordingly. On the motion of Mr. Casey (Treasurer), the House adopted the Report, and (the Standing Orders having previously been suspended, see page 190) the Bill was read a third time.

- 5. ADJOURNMENT.-Mr. Casey (Treasurer) moved, That the House do now adjourn. Debate ensued. Question ---put and passed.
- And then the House, at twenty-three minutes past four o'clock p.m., adjourned until Tuesday next at three o'clock p.m.
