- 2. PAPER.—The following Paper was presented, by command of His Royal Highness the Governor-General—

War-South-West Pacific-Report to the Prime Minister by the Acting Minister for the Army on alleged waste of man-power and materials for Headquarters accommodation at Lae, New Guinea.

- 3. ARMY HEADQUARTERS, LAE, NEW GUINEA—ALLEGED WASTE OF MAN-POWER AND MATERIALS— MINISTERIAL STATEMENT.—Mr. Dedman (Minister representing the Acting Minister for the Army), by leave, made a Ministerial Statement in respect of allegations of unwarranted waste of man-power and materials in the provision of accommodation for Headquarters at Lae, New Guinea.
- 4. EQUIPMENT OF AUSTRALIAN TROOPS—MINISTERIAL STATEMENT—MOTION FOR PRINTING PAPER.— The Order of the Day having been read for the resumption of the debate on the following motion of Mr. Curtin (Prime Minister), That the Paper [presented on the 22nd March], viz :--
