### TUESDAY, 26TH JUNE, 1906.

- 3. AUSTRALIAN INDUSTRIES PRESERVATION BILL.—The Order of the Day having been read for the resumption of the debate on the question, That the Bill be now read a second time— Debate resumed.

Mr. Wilks moved as an amendment, That all the words after the word "be" be omitted, with a view to insert in place thereof the words, "not further proceeded with until after the Tariff Commission has presented its Report on Metals and Machinery." Debate continued.
