HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

TUESDAY, 30TH AUGUST, 1910.

- 1. The House met pursuant to adjournment.—Mr. Speaker took the Chair, and read Prayers.
- LAND TAX ASSESSMENT BILL.—The Order of the Day having been read for the resumption of the debate on the question—That the Bill be now read a second time.
 Debate resumed.
 - Mr. Deakin moved an amendment, That, after the word "That", the following words be inserted, viz.:—"the form of land tax outlined by the Prime Minister, and provided for in this Bill, is unjust in its incidence and an abuse of Federal powers."
 - Debate continued.
 - Mr. Glynn addressing the House, and not having concluded his speech, the House ordered that he have leave to continue his speech when the debate is resumed.
 - Ordered—That the debate be now adjourned, and that the resumption of the debate be made an Order of the Day for to-morrow.
- 3. PAPER.—Mr. Frazer presented, pursuant to Statute—
 - Defence Act—Military Forces—Financial and Allowance Regulations Amended (Provisional) Nos. 155-159—Statutory Rules 1910, No. 75.
- 4. Adjournment.—Mr. Fisher moved, That the House do now adjourn. Question—put and passed.
- And then the House, at seventeen minutes past ten o'clock p.m., adjourned until to-morrow at half-past ten o'clock a.m.
