ADJOURNMENT-MOTION FOR PURPOSE OF DISCUSSION.—Mr. Rodgers rose in his place, and said that he proposed to move the adjournment of the House for the purpose of discussing a definite matter of urgent public importance, namely, "The agreement for the manufacture and sale of Australian Wool Tops between the Commonwealth Government and the Colonial Combing, Spinning, and Weaving Company Ltd."

Mr. Speaker thereupon called upon those Members who approved of the proposed discussion to rise in their places, and more than the necessary number of Members having risen accordingly---
