Please provide:

A full list of successful non-government schools by electorate including:

- a. How much each school received
- b. How much they applied to get
- c. Whether they were Round 1 or Round 2 applications

#### **Answer:**

a. The tables attached include the grants for non-government schools approved by the Minister as at 2 November 2005.

The closing date for schedules from Block Grant Authorities for recommended projects was 31 October 2005. Payments will be made progressively via the State and Territory Governments to the Block Grant Authorities, who then administer the funding to schools. DEST anticipates all 2005 payments being made by mid-December 2005.

b. The application and assessment processes for non-government school grants are conducted separately by each of the Block Grant Authorities. Those processes are not submission based and DEST receives the schedule of recommended projects.

c. The Block Grant Authorities received applications from non-government schools over the course of the year. There were not two discrete rounds for non-government schools.
