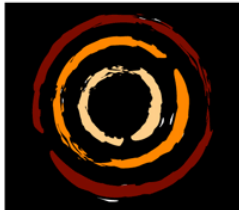

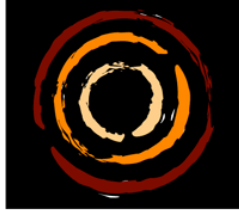

## **Attachment B - National Broadcasting Schedule**

The NIRS seeks to improve and develop a variety and quality of programs but seeks opportunities for expansion from our contributors to improve the schedule of the NIRS. At present the NIRS program mix includes:

### **Let's Talk – 98.9FM**

Produced by 98.9FM in Brisbane. Tiga Bayles hosts this program and share of Indigenous news, talkback and issues from throughout Australia.

### **Weekly News in Review – NINS**

Produced by the NIRS this is Indigenous news and views from throughout Australia. All stations take this feed to service their news requirements.

### **AWAYE - ABC**

Produced by the ABC includes news and ideas throughout Indigenous Australia.

### **The Mary G Show**

Produced by Mark Bin Barker an Indigenous Comedian. This program is sent via the NIRS to the national network via satellite.

### **Sweet Science**

Produced by the Gadigal and 3KND, this program profiles Australia's Indigenous Boxing exploits both nationally and internationally.

### **PAKAM**

A network program of different programs broadcast through the PAKAM network.

### **The Nut House – TEABBA**

Produced by TEABBA, this program represents the Top End Indigenous RIBS Network.

### **AFL Football**

In 1998, the NIRS did its first broadcast of the AFL from the Gabba in Brisbane. Since then the NIRS has produced over 300 programs including regular talk, match reviews, information segments and discussion during and after each game.

### **Country Affairs with Sandy Dan**

A live program produced by Sandy Dan from the PAKAM Network.



**The Aboriginal Program – SBS**

Produced live in the studios of SBS, this program is an informative weekly program featuring telephone interviews from people in many different parts of the country and quality discussion of political and other issues that are of interest to the network.

**Black Chat – Koori Radio**

A live program by Lola Forrester from Koori Radio in Sydney. This program strives to keep the whole country up to date with things that are going on in the Sydney region.

**Talkblack – Bumma Bipperra**

A live production by Bumma Bipperra Media from Cairns, Far North Queensland of news, views and entertainment from the Cairns region.

**Warren Williams – CAAMA**

A live program by Warren William from CAAMA in Alice Springs. This program is a Central Australian Country Music program from the Red Centre.

**Umeewarra - The Aboriginal Voice**

Produced by Indigenous community broadcasters from Port Augusta.
