Reserve Bank Governor to front House Economics Committee at Gold Coast Public Hearing 10.00am to 1.00pm, Friday, 17 August 2007

The House Economics Committee will hold a public hearing with the Reserve Bank at the Gold Coast on Friday, 17 August 2007.

At its most recent board meeting on 7 August 2007, the Bank chose to raise the cash rate to 6.50 per cent.

Committee Chairman, Bruce Baird (Member for Cook, NSW) said that the upcoming hearing looms as an important event. "The public hearing will provide the Committee with an opportunity to scrutinise the RBA over its management of monetary policy and, in particular, examine the issues behind the most recent rate rise," he said.

Reserve Bank Governor, Glenn Stevens, commented in his 8 August 2007 media release, that "stronger economic conditions were likely to put upward pressure on inflation".

Mr Baird said the Committee will be seeking more detail about short to medium term inflationary expectations. "The Committee will also seek views on other key issues, including the housing market, labour market shortages, and the international economy," he said.
