We were not able to vote in the last election, because we do not have firm plans as to the date of our return, and we left Australia just a little over two years before the election. But our Australian citizenship is important to us. We keep in close touch with Australian politics, and participate in it in various ways, eg most recently by supporting petitions and advertisements on refugee issues. We do intend to return to live in Australia one day, and we do not believe that we should have been disenfranchised simply because we have temporarily left our country.
