Dear Mr Brown,

I reply, on behalf of the Holy See, in respect to your letter of 18 October 2011.

The Holy See was pleased that the already established diplomatic relations with Australia were strengthened by the decision in 2008 to appoint a resident Ambassador in Rome. Furthermore, the Holy See considers it is important and useful for the Australian Government to have a direct and closer channel of dialogue over matters of mutual interest and concern.
