Unlike the UN1267 process, the UN Security Council does not have a centralised list of persons and entities to which UNSCR 1373 applies and has left Member States to determine for themselves who such persons and entities are. The Minister for Foreign Affairs may list a person or entity on a case-by-case basis if he is satisfied that they are associated with terrorism as described in subparagraph 1(c) of UNSCR 1373.
