Inquiry into Capacity Building in Indigenous Communities

Public Hearing - Canberra, Wednesday 23 October 2002

The House of Representatives Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Affairs Committee is examining strategies to assist Aboriginals and Torres Strait Islanders better manage the delivery of services within their communities.

In particular, the Committee is considering ways of building the capacities of: (a) **community members** to better support families, community organisations and representative councils so as to deliver the best outcomes for individuals, families and communities;

(b) **Indigenous organisations** to better deliver and influence the delivery of services in the most effective, efficient and accountable way; and

(c) **government agencies** so that policy direction and management structures will improve individual and community outcomes for Indigenous people.

The Committee will hear this afternoon (Wednesday 23 October) from the Australian National University's Centre for Aboriginal Economic Policy Research.
