QUESTION on NOTICE: Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations

Question (p. EE 22):

Mrs D'ATH—Will the workforce data set also be collecting information on whether teachers and teacher librarians are contract or permanent staff? Could you take that on notice because I am specifically talking about contract, not casual, as a distinctive part of employment.

Departmental Response:

The Department expects that data will be sought in relation to employment status, type of employment and time fraction employed. These categories are likely to include contract and permanent teaching positions for teachers, including specialist teacher librarians, for the national teacher workforce dataset being developed as part of the *Improving Teacher Quality National Partnership*.
