What would you ask the Reserve Bank Governor?

The Reserve Bank of Australia (RBA - www.rba.gov.au) is Australia's central bank, responsible for setting official **interest rates**. It also has oversight of the arrangements which allow consumers, businesses and other organisations to transfer funds between themselves and between financial institutions. This includes certain **credit card**, **EFTPOS and ATM fees**, known as 'interchange fees'.

Representatives of the Reserve are only publicly quizzed about their decision-making twice every year, each time by the **House of Representatives Economics Committee**. *This Friday is one of those hearings*.

STORY/SEGMENT IDEA:

As the hearing approaches, it might be interesting to ask the question: what would you like to ask the Governor of the Reserve Bank?

An interview could be conducted with the Chairman of the Committee which will question the Governor, asking about the process, and preparations etc, and then talk-back or a 'vox pop' conducted.
