19 July 2005 Inquiry into Overseas Adoptions starts in Queensland

The House of Representatives Family and Human Services Committee Chairman, Bronwyn Bishop, has announced that the Committee will hold public hearings in Brisbane on 21 and 22 July for its inquiry into overseas adoptions.

Mrs Bishop says the committee will examine the inconsistencies in approval processes between Queensland and other states and territories and the differences in benefits and entitlements received by both adoptive and birth parents.

The largest number of submissions to the inquiry came from Queensland. They include claims that couples have decided to leave Queensland and adopt elsewhere due to delays in processing applications. Queensland authorities also demand adoptive parents meet strict height-weight (body mass index) requirements.

"The guestion of adoptions in Queensland has raised a number of significant issues and that is why the committee will be hearing from Queensland first to better understand the difficulties faced. Adoption groups and parents alike in Queensland have welcomed this inquiry," Mrs Bishop said.

The public hearings will include community statements on Thursday, 21 July between 1:30pm and 2:30pm. Queenslanders who have adopted or want to adopt children are invited to share their views and experiences with the Committee. All are welcome.

"For many people, writing a submission can be an arduous task. But anyone can have their say and express their views for a few minutes on what they feel in their hearts and how things can be changed for the better," Mrs Bishop said.
