I refer to the letter, dated 15 March 2005, from the Chair of the Joint Standing Committee on Treaties to the Premier of Western Australia regarding the treaty, *Singapore-Australia Free Trade Agreement Amendments*, which was tabled in the Commonwealth Parliament on 15 March 2005. The following brief comments are submitted for the consideration of the Committee.

- (i) That two further Australian universities have been given recognition for their law degrees and, in particular, Murdoch University, is welcomed.
- (ii) With respect to the annex on food standards under chapter 5, although this is not strictly a free trade agreement issue, there is some concern of a negative impact on Western Australian food suppliers if cheaply produced food products were exported to Australia to take advantage of reduced freight rates for chiller containers returning to Perth.
