Improved social security access for Australian and Hungarian retirees

The Parliament's Joint Standing Committee on Treaties will today examine an agreement between Australia and the Republic of Hungary on Social Security.

This Agreement provides for enhanced access to Australian and Hungarian retirement benefits and greater portability of these benefits between the two countries. People who move between Australia and Hungary will be able to do so in the knowledge that their rights to benefits are recognised in both countries.

"This agreement will facilitate business between Australia and Hungary by ensuring employers and employees do not have double liability in respect of the same work of an employee. The Agreement will bring economic and social benefits to Australia and facilitate business links between the two countries by reducing costs" Committee Chair, Mr Kelvin Thomson MP, said. "It will also help to maximise the foreign income of Australian residents and there will be flow-on effects within the Australian economy."

The Committee will also examine a series of treaties with the Marshall Islands, Mauritius and Montserrat regarding various taxation issues.
