DEAR SIRS.

IT IS THE SUBMISSION OF THIS EXECUTIVE THAT THIS TREATY NOT BE RATIFIED. IT IS OUR POLICY THAT IF AN AUSTRALIAN CITIZEN COMMITS ANY OFFENCE OVERSEAS THEN THAT PERSON SHOULD EXPECT TO PAY FOR THAT CRIME UNDER THE LAW OF THAT NATION. WE DO NOT BELIEVE THAT THEY SHOULD BE GIVEN ANY LEGAL OR MORAL SUPPORT. WE REGARD ANY CRIMINAL ACT AS UNAUSTRALIAN, WHY SHOULD WE GIVE THE REWARD OF AN EASY PRISON LIFE IN AUSTRALIA, CRIMINALS SHOULD BE TREATED IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE VICTIMS. SAYING SORRY IS NOT ENOUGH, PUNISH THEM SO THEY NEVER REOFFEND. THESE POOR PEOPLE MAY NEVER SEE FAMILY OR FRIENDS EVER AGAIN, WELL THAT WILL BE THEIR OWN FAULT. DRUG DEALERS, MOLESTORS OF OUR YOUNG AND KILLERS SHOULD BE TREATED AS ANIMALS. CHAINED AND BEATEN LIKE THEY DESERVE. THE EXECUTIVE WISH TO THANK THE COMMITTEE FOR ALLOWING US TO COMMENT ON THIS TREATY.
