

Thank you for your letter of 24 September 2008 inviting the ACT Government to make a submission to your committee's consideration of the proposal for new works at the Australian War Memorial.

I am advised that the proposed extent of the new works at the Eastern Precinct will be for the construction of a new National Service Memorial and significant improvements to public facilities and associated coach and car parking arrangements at the Australian War Memorial.
