



Public Works Committee to hold public hearing for CSIRO Clayton Property Strategy, Victoria

The Public Works Committee is holding a public hearing on Monday in Melbourne, for its inquiry into the CSIRO Clayton Property Strategy, Victoria.

The CSIRO proposes to relocate its staff and research from Highett Melbourne to its Clayton Site adjacent to Monash University. The project includes the refurbishment and fit-out of some existing facilities at Clayton and North Clayton; the relocation of staff and specialist science equipment; and the construction of the Factories of the Future Innovation (FoFi) Centre at Clayton. This will consolidate CSIRO's support facilities and research capability and reduce CSIRO's building footprint and reduce overall building operation, management and maintenance costs.

Construction is scheduled to commence in June 2014. The Highett Relocation component of the project is scheduled to be completed by September 2015, and the FoFi component is scheduled to be completed by December 2015. Staff are expected to be relocated by December 2015.

The estimated cost of the project is \$32 million.
