Public hearing for inquiry into Defence housing development in Warner, Queensland

The Public Works Committee is holding a public hearing for the inquiry into the proposed development and construction of housing for Defence at Warner in the northern suburbs of Brisbane.

DHA proposes to develop approximately 465 allotments for the provision of developed land and housing in Warner to assist in satisfying future housing demand for Defence personnel. DHA intends to construct houses for Defence families on 130 lots. The remaining 335 residential lots, and potentially the 2.1 hectare super lot, will be sold to the general market.

The estimated cost of the project is \$91.3 million. Construction is expected to be complete by December 2016.
