Public hearing in Sydney for two war ships inquiries

The Public Works Committee is holding a public hearing for two inquiries:

- Air warfare destroyer ship sustainment facilities at Garden Island, Randwick Barracks and HMAS Watson, Sydney, NSW (AWD)
- Landing helicopter dock ship sustainment facilities at Garden Island and Randwick Barracks, Sydney, NSW (LHD)

The projects aim to provide permanent training, systems support and maintenance facilities, and berthing infrastructure in order to sustain capability for new Hobart Class air warfare destroyers and new Canberra Class landing helicopter dock ships.

The estimated cost of the AWD project is \$109.9 million. The estimated cost of the LHD project is \$60.3 million. Construction for both projects is expected to be complete by late 2015.
