The Murray Darling Basin provides food for Australia (including big cities) and for export, the removal of any water from farmers would severely reduce their capacity to produce the food needed.

It would also have a dramatic effect on the environment in this area, affecting animals and birds and trees which rely on the irrigation system to survive.

The lower lakes could be filled by removing the barrages, letting the sea water in, as is the natural thing to happen.
