Crimes Legislation Amendment (Powers, Offences and Other Measures) Bill 2015 [passed by the House of Representatives 12 August 2015] [Minister's second reading speech]

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Agriculture (Senator Colbeck) tabled documents relating to the Roe 8 extension and the Perth Freight Link [The documents were tabled in response to the order of the Senate agreed to on 11 August 2015]

The Senate <u>ordered</u> the Minister representing the Minister for Education and Training to table documents concerning higher education reforms—to table by no later than 11 am on 19 August 2015 [a <u>statement</u> was made]

Proposed suspension of standing orders

The Senate did not agree to a <u>motion</u> moved by the Leader of the Australian Greens (Senator Di Natale) to suspend standing orders to enable debate on a motion relating to the *Marriage Act 1961* [first speaker]

Statement by President

The President made a <u>statement</u> relating to the wearing of sporting and other insignia-bearing attire in the chamber
