I am replying in lan's absence.

I can confirm that, based on the facts of your birth (in Australia on 17th January 1973 to a UK born mother), you do not have a claim to British citizenship. This is because, prior to 1 January 1983 when the British Nationality Act (BNA) 1981 came into force, British nationality could only be passed down through the male line to children born overseas.

British mothers before 1 January 1983 - however this required a positive action of application - followed by a ceremony at which A provision was introduced in 2003, by way of an amendment to the BNA 1981, which allowed for the Registration of persons born to citizenship is awarded to successful applicants.
