AS PART OF MY SECURITY VETTING TO WORK AT THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE, DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND AS FOREIGN POLICY/NATIONAL SECURITY ADVISER TO THE PRIME MINISTER, I UNDERWENT A THOROUGH PROCESS TO ESTABLISH AND CONFIRM THAT I AM SOLELY AN AUSTRALIAN CITIZEN.

I UNDERWENT ANOTHER THOROUGH VETTING PROCESS UPON BEING PRESELECTED AS A LABOR PARTY CANDIDATE IN FEBRUARY 2016. MY STATUS AS ONLY AN AUSTRALIAN CITIZEN WAS CONFIRMED BY EGYPTIAN AUTHORITIES IN APRIL 2016.

Dear Mr Khalil,

With reference to your contact with the Embassy in April 2016 and your email dated 28 of July 2017, concerning your eligibility of Federal candidates, MPs and Senators under S.44 of the Australian constitution.

We would like to re-confirm to you that according to our records your Egyptian parents became naturalised Australian citizens in 1971 and 1972. Under Egyptian Law Egyptians who obtain foreign citizenship relinquish their Egyptian citizenship unless within a year of the date of acquiring foreign citizenship they apply with appropriate Egyptian officials to retain their Egyptian citizenship and hold dual citizenship as your parents did not do so and thereby relinquished their Egyptian citizenship.

Our records show as well that you have never applied for or received Egyptian Citizenship by descent under Egyptian Law.
