My family don't hold records of the dates of birth of my maternal and paternal grandparents, however, based on family recollection they were born and lived on the island of Cephalonia.

In response to the above, under reference, document regarding the subject issue, we communicate the following:

According to article 27 of the Greek Nationality Code (L.3284/2004) combined with article 1 of the Provisions Code for Male Registries (L.2119/1993), the acquisition of greek nationality/citizenship is proven by the registration within the Municipal and Male Registries (cases of males) of the Greek State.

In the specific case, and after investigation conducted by our Offices, no such registration of Athanasios (Arthur) Sinodinos of Dionysios and Kalifronia, born in 1957 in Australia, in either the Municipal of Male Registries appeared.

Consequently, as no registration ever took place within the Municipal or Male Registrics of any Municipality of the State, he can not be considered a Greek citizen/national, nor is he considered to have Greek citizenship, as per the provisions of the aforementioned legislation.
