- 1. What qualifications does each of the staff members have?
- 2. What checks are done to ensure that the qualifications are true and correct?
- 3. How many specialist counsellors are employed on the 1800 RESPECT hotline?

Answer:

- 1. Staff must have a degree in Social Work, Psychology or equivalent and at least three years counselling experience.
- 2. Counsellors are recruited through a specialist recruitment agency. All qualifications and statements of employment are verified.
