**Senator Fifield** asked:

It was 4 months ago that we heard about the MOU with the states regarding this funding and its lack of reporting requirements. 4 months ago you were unable to tell me where exactly the provided places are. Have you now been able to find out where these supported places that the Government has funded are? Please provide the Committee with a breakdown of the places delivered by federal electorate. Senator McLucas have you been invited to and/or attended the opening of any places?

**Answer:**

Under the Memorandum of Understanding, jurisdictions are required to provide information on the location of supported accommodation facilities when they submit their final project report on completion of these facilities and has not been collated by Federal Electorate.

Senator McLucas has not attended any openings of any places.
