Written Question on Notice

Senator Scullion asked:

- a) Do you have some statistics on Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in the workforce?
- b) Possibly separated into those in the hospital environment and those elsewhere?

Answer:

a) The estimated number of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Workers varies between sources from 1600 (state and territory data) to 961 (Australian Bureau of Statistics). The below data from the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) and the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare (AIHW) is the most current comprehensive data available on the participation of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in the health workforce.
