How many communities have taken down signs that were put up as a result of the intervention?

Answer:

Community signs have been redesigned to include more respectful wording in the following Alice Springs Town Camps: Irklancha Atwacha, Namatjira and Walpiri.

Community signs have been removed in Ampilatwatja, Canteen Creek, Lajamanu, Mutitjulu, Warruwi and Yuendumu. The Department is working with these communities on redesigning their community signs to include more respectful messaging to ensure restrictions are appropriately communicated.
